

Role: People's Voice support Worker

Sessional: Flexible, sessional hours, usually during office hours 8am- 6pm

Location: Office based (Fishponds) with some work carried out in community spaces.

Salary: £10.99 per hour plus 12.07% annual leave entitlement

Hours: Flexible hours

Everyone wants to make a difference, right? But how many of us can say that our work has a positive impact on the lives of other people, day in, day out? This is an exciting opportunity to support the Project Workers who work on the People's Voice project. The Project Workers are setting up a new organisation/ group run by people with a learning disability or difficulty for people with a learning disability or difficulty.

We are looking for an efficient, supportive individual, someone with strong personal values and a desire to make a difference to people's lives. Experience of support work or similar is necessary and an understanding of the challenges people with a learning difference face.

The role will involve working in a person-centred way to support the project workers whilst in work with elements of their role they need help with. This could be administrative tasks, understanding emails or meeting content, emotionally supporting the team to attend new spaces and helping practically with things such as travel arrangements.

This role is open to anyone however we do particularly welcome applications from people with lived experience of disability and from any other minoritized groups.
